


EFFAB – The Voice of EU Animal Breeders




Breeding program:

Improved animal health and welfare





Code EFABAR


- The code of good practices for **Responsible and Balanced Farm Animal and Aquaculture Breeding**.

(bioconversion efficiency residual, longevity...)




EFFAB's role in EU Projects


- Supporting the **co-design** and **co-creation** of research proposals.


